






PLATO'S CAVE

- PLATO IS A FAMOUS ANCIENT GREEK PHILOSOPHER WHO WAS VERY CONCERNED WITH THE NATURE OF REALITY.
- HE WROTE A FAMOUS ANALOGY ABOUT A PRISONERS LOCKED IN A CAVE . THE CAVE IS THE ONLY WORLD THE PRISONERS HAVE EVER KNOWN.
 THIS IS THEIR REALITY. ONE DAY A PRISONER ESCAPES AND DISCOVERS THE REAL WORLD OUTSIDE. PLATO BELIEVED OUR WORLD IS LIKE THE CAVE AND THERE IS A TRUER, MORE REAL WORLD OUTSIDE OF THIS ONE.

- 1963 1965 MYRA HINDLEY KILLED FIVE CHILDREN (10-17) WITH HER PARTNER IAN BRADY
- ALL THE CHILDREN WERE SEXUALLY ASSAULTED AND TORTURED BEFORE THEIR MURDER




 IAN BRADY AND MYRA HINDLEY TAPE RECORDED THE TORTURE AND MURDER OF THEIR YOUNG VICTIMS.

 THE MOTHER OF ONE VICTIM HAD TO LISTEN TO THE VOICE OF HER DAUGHTER
 SCREAMING AS SHE WAS BEING MURDERED
 IN ORDER TO IDENTIFY HER DAUGHTER



 DR HAROLD SHIPMAN MURDERED AT LEAST 236 OF HIS PATIENTS OVER 24 YEARS BETWEEN 1974 AND 1998.

- HE WAS AND REMAINS BRITAIN'S MOST PROLIFIC SERIAL KILLER.
- HE COMMITTED SUICIDE IN PRISON
 IN JANUARY 2004



- IRMA GRESE WAS AN OFFICER IN THE SS.
- SHE WAS ACCUSED OF PERSONALLY KILLING 30 PRISONERS A DAY AT AUSCHWITZ.
- SHE SET DOGS ON SOME, BEAT OTHERS TO DEATH AND WHIPPED OTHERS.
- SHE WAS ACCUSED OF HAVING A LAMPSHADE MADE FROM THE SKIN OF ONE OF HER VICTIMS.

WHAT DO WORDS LIKE 'EVIL' AND 'BAD' ACTUALLY MEAN?



DIFFERENT GROUPS OF PEOPLE HAVE VERY DIFFERENT IDEAS AND BELIEFS ABOUT GOOD, BAD, RIGHT AND WRONG. THIS IS CALLED THEIR ETHICS. E.G.....

IN UK ALCOHOL IS SEEN AS SOMETHING WHICH IS GOOD. WE LIKE TO GO TO THE PUB AND HAVE A DRINK. IN SAUDI ARABIA, ALL ALCOHOL IS FORBIDDEN BY LAW.

SOLDIERS ARE ENCOURAGED TO KILL PEOPLE. BUT THEY ARE NOT ALLOWED TO DO THIS UNLESS UNDER ORDERS TO DO SO. (MILITARY ETHICS).

THE ELDERLY IN INUIT CULTURE ARE TAKEN TO SEA, AND SET ADRIFT ON A FLOATING ICEBERG. THIS IS SEEN AS THE RIGHT THING TO DO WHEN YOUNGER MEMBERS COULD STARVE DUE TO LACK OF FOOD.



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
SHOULD IMAGES OF GOD REFLECT THIS?



- <u>PHILOSOPHY</u>: PLATO'S FORM OF THE GOOD HAS A LOT IN COMMON WITH ARISTOTLE'S PRIME MOVER. DISCUSS 40 MARKS
- <u>ETHICS:</u> KANTIAN ETHICS ARE HELPFUL FOR MORAL DECISION MAKING IN EVERY KIND OF CONTEXT. DISCUS 40 MARKS
- <u>DCT:</u> DISCUSS CRITICALLY THE VIEW THAT CHRISTIANS CAN DISCOVER TRUTHS ABOUT GOD USING HUMAN REASON. 40 MARKS







- YOU WILL FIND ETHICAL AND PHILOSOPHICAL QUESTIONS INTERESTING AND ENJOY THE INTELLECTUAL CHALLENGE OF THEM.
- YOU ARE LIKELY TO DO VERY WELL WHEN YOU DO YOUR EXAMS. ANECDOTAL RESEARCH SUGGESTS A STRONG LINK BETWEEN ENJOYMENT AND PERFORMANCE AT A LEVEL.
