On Wednesday 14th of October, we plan to assess students using a computer-adaptive assessment. This assessment will provide us with baseline information on each student's aptitude as well as information on strengths and areas for development. In the absence of formal Key Stage 2 assessments in the summer of 2020, the baseline assessment of students has become even more important and it will be used for setting, target grades and appropriate student interventions moving forward.

The assessment will take approximately 50 minutes and will be based around Literacy and Numeracy skills. It is not something students need to prepare for.
