Thank you for supporting your child to access their home learning on Google Classroom. Teachers are receiving some excellent work and we are proud of the hard work and determination of many of our students. We can provide you with regular information about your child's online engagement:

- Missing work—Work not turned in when the summary was sent.
- Upcoming work—Work that's due today and tomorrow (for daily emails) or that's due in the upcoming week (for weekly emails).
- Class activities—Announcements, assignments, and questions recently posted by teachers.

To get email summaries of your child's work, you should accept an email invitation which will arrive over the next few days (you can unsubscribe at any time).
