Dear Parents and Carers of Y11 and Y13 Students

Teacher-marked Assessments

You will recall that we were required to postpone the mock examinations which were scheduled to take place in January due to the closure of school. I write to inform you that these teacher-marked assessments will take place in examination conditions during the fortnight commencing Monday 15 March. A full timetable of assessments for this fortnight will be shared in due course.

Centre Assessed Grades will once again be used this academic year to determine final outcomes. We await the full detail from Ofqual about how these will be determined. However, it is very likely that the results of these teacher-marked assessments will be **one of** the pieces of evidence used to determine the Centre Assessed Grades for your child. It is therefore imperative that your child applies themselves appropriately to their learning at all times, allowing us to have a clear picture and vital evidence to back up where they are on their learning journey.

Full information about the subject content to be tested in the teacher-marked assessments was shared with your child before the Christmas break, and this information will be reshared via Google Classroom for each subject. However, if your child is in any doubt about what will be tested in each assessment, I would encourage them to seek support and guidance from their teachers via the typed chat function in Google Classroom.

Whilst your child continues to learn from home, they should continue to work hard and follow their normal lesson timetable. They should now additionally be continuing to prepare for their teachermarked assessments using the revision materials provided by their subject teachers.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your continued support. We understand that this is an incredibly unsettling time and that the uncertainties also place additional pressures on your families. When the Government provides clarity from its examination consultations, rest assured that we will be in touch.
