Dear Parent/Carer

Following discussions with the local Public Health team this afternoon, we have been asked to close our Year 7 bubble to the majority of students. This is due to an increased number of positive COVID cases across the year group this week.

Full details are as follows:

- Year 7 students who are currently isolating and expecting to return to school on Monday 28th June should return to school as expected. We are working to ensure that a full deep clean of the Y7 bubble area is conducted over the weekend to allow for Monday's return.
- Year 7 students who are currently isolating with a return date of Monday 5th July (contacted yesterday) are able to return as expected on this date.
- All other Year 7 students should self-isolate until the end of Monday 5th July and should therefore return to school on Tuesday 6th July.

The Public Health team have requested that all Year 7 students book a PCR test (other than those returning to school on Monday 28th June). This can be done by following this link https://www.gov.uk/get-coronavirus-test-or-by-calling 119

If you are unsure of your child's return date, please contact Admin@st-wilfrids.org

Due to the need for the majority of the year group to learn remotely during this time, our in-school assessments are postponed until all students return to school – new timetables will be shared with students next week.
