Summer School 2021 Statement

During the 2021 summer holidays, the pupils entering Year 7 in September 2021 were invited to attend the academy's Summer School. Over the course of 5 days, pupils engaged in a number of carefully planned activities designed to support them in transitioning to Secondary School, allowing them to familiarise themselves with the school environment and the staff who will support them from September 2021, and to allow 'catch-up' activities particularly in English, Maths and Science.

Pupils took part in a wide range of activities including; a trip to Beamish, a trip to Emmaus Youth Village and a carousel of curriculum and enrichment sessions.
