


### What is it All About?


Firstly, an **enterprise** is simply another name for a business.

**The Role:** They work with companies to help them change and identify ways of improving.


The Salary: £21k-£31k to start rising to £39k-£50 with experience.

### Chief Executive Officer


The Role: Leading entire businesses ensuring that policies are planned and put into place to ensure the business is successful.
