### St. Wilfrid's Uniform Reminder

### School Badges

As you are aware we have updated the school badge to include House colours in order to negate the requirement for coloured braid on the blazer. All pupils will receive a school badge this year which can be ironed onto their blazer if, and when, the blazer is replaced. A plain black blazer with no badge should now be purchased when replacing their current blazer as we gradually phase out the current badge and braids.



### School uniform update reminders

- **Jumpers – all year groups** will move to a traditional woollen grey school jumper with no embroidered school badge; these will remain an optional for pupils to wear. These can be purchased from any school uniform supplier including supermarkets and department stores.



- **School Skirts** will change to a generic grey **permanent pleated knee length school** skirt with no school badge. These can be purchased from any school uniform supplier including supermarkets and department stores.
- **Ties** - Year 10 going into year 11 will be the only students able to wear the school tie with the school crest on it, all other year groups should wear what was the traditional school tie at KS3



I would also like to remind you of our shoe guidance for September. Black formal school shoes should be worn, not trainers or any shoe with logos (including Vivienne Westwood pumps, which are NOT allowed).
