#### The Sacraments

Sacraments are rituals performed in the church that bring people into holiness.

- <u>Baptism:</u> Welcoming a person into the family of God. <u>SOWA</u>: "Go & make disciples of all nations." (Matthew)
- Reconciliation: Forgiveness of Sins. SOWA: "If you forgive sins, they are forgiven" (John)
- Eucharist: Receiving the Body & Blood of Christ. SOWA: "This is My Body, this is my Blood" (Luke)
- Confirmation: Choosing to continue your faith as an adult. SOWA: "The Holy Spirit...teach you things" (John)
- Matrimony: Joining two people together as one in a marriage. SOWA: "What God has put together, let no man put asunder" (Matthew)
- Holy Orders: When a man becomes a Priest.
   SOWA: "He appointed the 12." (Matthew)
- Anointing of the Sick: Healing & forgiveness of sins. SOWA: "Disciples healed many that were sick" (Matthew)

#### **Prayer**

Prayer is a communication with God. There are 5 types of prayer for Catholics.

- Adoration: God is worth of Love.
   SOWA: "Glory be to the Father"
- Thanksgiving: Expressing Love & Gratitude to God. Example: Grace before meals.
- Repentance: Acknowledging you have sinned & asking for forgiveness.
   SOWA: I Confess to Almighty God...
  (Nicene Creed)
- Intercession: Praying on behalf of others. Example: Bidding prayers at Mass.
- 5. <u>Petition:</u> Asking God to help you. <u>Example: Prayer before an exam.</u>

## <u>Liturgical Worship</u>

A structured way of worship that takes place in RC churches.

- 1. <u>Introductory Rite:</u> Welcomed to Mss & Confess Sin.
- <u>Liturgy of the Word:</u> Reading from OT & NT, Homily & Creed.
- 3. <u>Liturgy of the Eucharist:</u>
  Catholics believe they received the Body & Blood of Jesus.
- 4. Concluding Rite:

Prayer & Dismissal- Go & spread the Word of God.

#### **Pilgrimage**

A journey to a place of religious significance. Pilgrimages allow Catholics to spend time becoming closer to God & spend time in prayer.

- 1. <u>Rome:</u> Vatican where the Pope lives & many religious figures are buried.
- **2.** <u>Lourdes:</u> Mary appeared to Saint Bernadette. A place of healing.
- **3.** <u>Jerusalem:</u> To walk the final journey Jesus took to his crucifixion.
- **4.** <u>Walsingham:</u> Visions of Mary & a place of healing.

## **Catholic Social Teaching**

The church teachings that we should love our neighbour as well as God.

# <u> 3 Aims:</u>

- Justice: Promote justice & end injustice in the world.
- **2.** <u>Peace:</u> Encourage harmony among all humans.
- **3.** <u>Reconciliation:</u> Protect the dignity of one another. (Human Rights)

## **CAFOD**

(Mark)

Helps lots of people throughout the world by working for social justice, helps people help themselves (after natural disasters, war etc.) raises awareness of issues. SOWA:" Love your neighbour as yourself"

#### Mission & Evangelisation

- Mission Work: The idea that people are sent to help others-CAFOD is an example of Mission work. SOWA: "Love your neighbour as yourself" (Matthew)
- Evangelisation: To go out & live the Gospel- Spread the Word of God- SOWA: "Go & make disciples of all nations." (Matthew)
- Local: Going to Mass, Charity work- CAFOD, fundraising etc.
- **2.** <u>National:</u> Working for change in our country- raising awareness of injustice.
- 3. <u>Globally:</u> Following teachings of the Pope, Mission Work- CAFOD.

# <u>Funeral Rite</u>

This is a the beginning of the journey towards eternal life with God.

- Vigil of the Deceased: To say prayers for the person that has died.
- 2. Communion with the Deceased:
  Remind people that they are all one in Christ- belong to the family of God.
- 3. <u>Burial & Committal:</u> Remind people that death is not the end & that their loved ones are on their way to heaven.

## Popular Piety/Non Liturgical Worship

This is an unstructured way of worship in Catholic churches & allows people to worship in different ways.

- 1. <u>Stations of the Cross:</u> Used to tell the final journey Jesus took to his crucifixion
- **2.** <u>Rosary:</u> Used to focus on 'Mysteries of the Rosary' Catholics use beads to help them to pray.
- 3. <u>Eucharistic Adoration:</u> Praying in front of the Blessed Sacrament (Jesus)

# Roman Catholic Christianity Sources of Wisdom & Authority Knowledge Organiser

#### The Bible

The Bible is one book, that has many authors. There are many types of writing in the Bible.

#### **Old Testament:**

- <u>Law:</u> Decalogue (10 Commandments) given to Moses...
- **2.** <u>History:</u> Stories of Jewish history-Abraham, Moses etc.
- **3.** <u>**Prophets:**</u> Jonah & the whale, Daniel & Lions Den teach us about God.

## New Testament:

- 1. <u>Gospels:</u> Contain stories & teachings of Jesus.
- 2. <u>Letters:</u> St Paul wrote these teaching Christians how to live as God wanted.
- **3.** Revelation: A book describing the end of the world.

## <u>Interpretation of the Bible</u>

- Inspired Word of God: <u>Catholic</u> view- God inspires humans, they wrote the Bible.
- <u>Literal Word of God: Creationist</u> view, believe the Bible word for word.
- 3. <u>Liberal View: Other Christians</u> view, allows a closeness to God and contains spiritual not literal truths.

## The Magisterium

The Magisterium are the leaders of the RC Church.

- 1. Pope is the Head of the Church.
- Cardinal is a bishop chosen by the Pope.
- 3. Archbishop: Head of an arch diocese.
- 4. Bishop: Head of a diocese.
- 5. <u>Priest:</u> is in charge of a Parish.

The Magisterium is a living, teaching office of the Church today.

This means that they interpret the Bible to cover issues that didn't exist in the time of Jesus- e.g.- contraception, same sex marriage.

SOWA: "Interpreting the Word of God... trusted to the Magisterium." (CCC)

## **Second Vatican Council**

This was a large gathering held at the Vatican to discuss teaching & belief in the modern world.

## Some changes made during the meeting:

- 1. Jews no longer blamed for the death of Jesus.
- 2. Mass is said in the local language.
- 3. Lay people can take part in Mass.

## 4 Documents produced.

- 1. <u>Lumen Gentium:</u> Catholic & Protestant relationships.
- 2. <u>Sacrosanctum Concilium:</u> Changed the Mass.
- 3. <u>Dei Verbum:</u> Teachings from the Bible.
- 4. Gaudium Et Spes: Human relationships in society.

## Church as the Body of Christ

This links to the teaching that we all have a role to play within the Christian community.

- 1. <u>Laity:</u> The people that attend Mass, follow the Sacraments etc.
- 2. <u>Clergy:</u> The people that lead the worship- Magisterium Priest etc.
- **3.** Religious: Monks & Nuns who pray for the needs of the world.

SOWA: "The body is one & has many members" (Corinthians)

#### Mary as a Model of the Church

Mary is important to Catholics as she followed God & Jesus throughout her life.

- Joined with Jesus: Mary is the immaculate Conception & Mother of God. SOWA; Mary's role...inseperable from Christ." (CCC)
- 2. <u>Discipleship:</u> She does as she is asked without question. Follows God & Jesus. <u>SOWA: Behold I am the handmaid of the Lord. (Luke)</u>
- 3. Faith & Charity: Mary accepted carrying Jesus and obeys God. She is with her son Jesus at the foot of the cross & never doubts her faith. SOWA: "Mary is the model of faith & charity. (CCC)

#### Four Marks of the Church

These are a declaration of the Catholic faith.

- 1. <u>One:</u> There is only one Church, one Body in Christ. Prevents division with other Christians.
- Holy: The Church itself is holy as it links to Jesus. Allows participation in 7 Sacraments.
- Catholic: Meaning it is spread throughout the world. Everyone who shares in it shares the same beliefs.
- **4.** <u>Apostolic:</u> Follows the teachings of the disciples. Allows for the Magisterium to interpret scripture.

# Personal & Ethical Decision Making

Jesus is a role model for Christians & they follow his teachings.

- Love Others: Take care of those in need. SOWA: "your neighbour as yourself." (Matthew)
- Forgiveness: This is how we gain salvation, we must forgive others in order to be forgiven. SOWA: "Jesus forgives those who crucified him." (Luke)
- Servanthood: Jesus was the Servant King- sent to help others. SOWA: "Last Supper told us to love one another." (John)
- Social Justice: We need to help those in need. SOWA: Parable of the Sheep & Goats. (Matthew)
