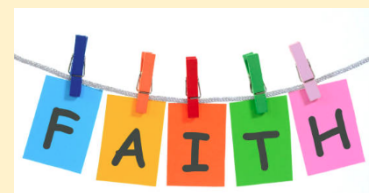

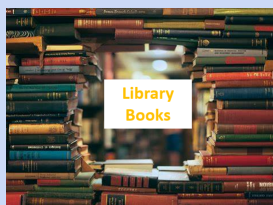

Duke of Edinburgh's Award - Year 8

On Friday 30th June, Year 8 students attended an assembly about the Duke of Edinburgh's Bronze Award, which will be offered to current Year 8 students, next academic year. During the assembly, students received information about the Physical, Skills and Volunteering sections of the programme, which run for 3 months each. Students must also select one section to continue for a further 3 month period. They must also complete a 2-day, 1-night expedition within the regional area, which will be organised alongside trained staff within the local authority.

Students were given an application form which they must complete and hand to Miss Dunn no later than Friday 14th July, if they would like to be considered for a place on the Bronze Award.
