Dear Year 11 Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to confirm that our Year 11 Prom will take place on Wednesday 19th June 2024 from 7pm in the Bishop's Suite at the Ramside Hall. As in previous years, students will need to make their own transport arrangements to and from the event. The Prom will finish promptly at 11pm and all students must be collected by this time.

The cost of attending the Prom is £40 which includes:

- A glass of non-alcoholic punch on arrival
- A traditional two course meal
- Decorations for the room and tables
- A disco

If you would like your child to attend the event you will need to make a payment of £40 on ParentPay using your usual log in details. **Payments must be received by Friday 17th May 2024.** In making your payment, you will also be consenting to your child attending the event.

You will also be consenting to the behavioural expectations of both the school and Ramside Hall as an external venue. Security staff are in operation at the venue for the safety of all attendees. Security staff will not permit alcohol, vapes, cigarettes or any banned or illegal items to be brought into our Prom suite. Please ensure you have communicated this to your child, as searches will take place upon entry to the venue.

I must also remind all parents that attending the Prom is a privilege that can be revoked. The school reserves the right to remove a place to any student whose behaviour or attendance gives significant cause for concern, before or during the event. Prom is the highlight of many young people's school career, and we hope that our students will remember their Prom for many years. We expect all of our students to behave responsibly and respectfully and to enjoy what we hope is an evening of fun, celebration and making memories.
