# Year 11 GCSE Examinations

Dear Families,

I hope this letter finds you well. I wanted to provide you with all the key information for our Year 11 pupils in order to ensure that the forthcoming weeks go as smoothly as possible for you and your child.

Firstly, I want to say how proud we are of Year 11 and the work they have done so far. The next few weeks are crucially important and I am sure you will agree that having a well-structured revision programme in place is essential for success. In addition to this, please do encourage your child to take a sensible amount of time out from their studies, making sure they get plenty of rest and exercise is just as important as revising at this stage of Year 11.

Below I have outlined key pieces of information and I encourage you to take the time to read this with your child.

## Examinations

- GCSE written examinations start on Thursday 8th May 2025.
- Pupils have been provided with individual timetables. The full exam timetable is available <u>here</u>.
- Unless otherwise stated, morning exams begin at 0900 and afternoon exams begin at 1300.
- Pupils should arrive at least 15 minutes prior to the start of exams.
- If for any reason your child is delayed or absent, it is essential that the school is contacted immediately please call reception on 0191 4569121.
- Pupils must be considerate of others and ensure they are well behaved at all times

## **Examination Contingency**

- Whilst the examination timetable is set, this year's contingency dates have been organised in case a national event means dates / times of exams change.
- We are required to ensure that some dates are kept available should there be any need for contingency arrangements. Contingency days are designed to be used in the event of national or significant local disruption to examinations, and all pupils taking exams during the summer season must be available on these days.
- I therefore remind you that pupils are required to be available up to and including:
  0 11 June [pm]
  0 25 June [am and pm]
